**This Week's Missions Prayer Point**  
**Rich & Ginger Jorgensen serving**  
**N2N (Nation 2 Nation University)**

**Rich & Ginger will be traveling to promote the ministry and be with us on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

Rich will be traveling with the N2N team to Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of Congo, this summer to train 100-200 pastors to establish N2N local-church Bible schools in churches--then on to the city of Matadi to train more pastors. Rich asks us for prayer to raise \$6,000 (that he and each team member will need) to cover the expenses of that trip. For that reason, Ginger won't be going with him. This will be the greatest N2N outreach in the Congo thus far, and extremely important because of the extreme lack of Bible training most pastors have there.
