BREAKING NEWS! This morning, we are praying for the new mission outreach we have just begun to support financially and prayerfully.

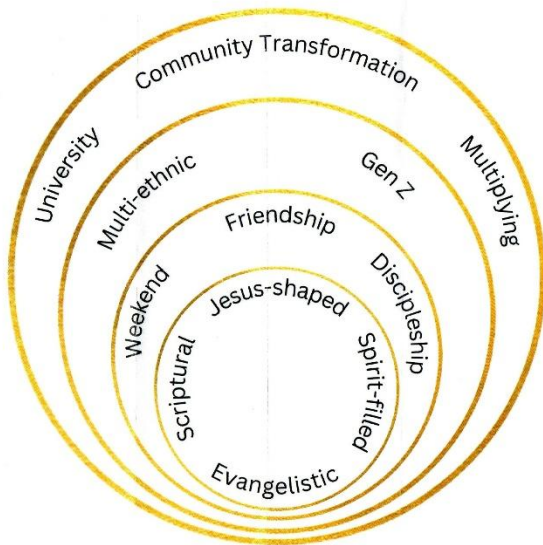
FLOWER CITY CHURCH in Rochester, NY by **Rev. Nathan and Emily Sanders**.
